### **The Village of Warsaw will hold a Public Open House on November 10, 2025, and wants your input on revitalization strategies for downtown and underutilized sites in the Village**

The Village of Warsaw is developing a plan to address underutilized and vacant buildings in the Village, with a focus on the downtown area and industrial properties including the former Village landfill. The first public meeting to introduce the project will be held on November 10, 2025 at the Spotlight Theater, 23 S. Main Street, Warsaw, NY from 5-7 p.m. Participants can attend any time between 5-7 p.m.

Primary objectives of the project are to develop transformational strategies to revitalize buildings, sites, and areas that will transform the Village and support a vibrant local economy. This effort builds upon existing plans and projects, including the Village's recently adopted Comprehensive Plan.

Completion of the plan will also help the Village with obtaining grants and financial incentives for redevelopment in the area. Funding for the project is provided by the New York State Department of State's Office of Planning and Development.
